#### **Amenities at Camp Long Lake**

- Four meals will be served by Camp Long Lake. Saturday, am, noon, pm, and Sunday am. It is impossible to go hungry at River Rats.
- We get one trip to haul all our gear to the campsite in a vehicle or trailer. We can load up your gear in that vehicle and make that trip up to our site at about 6:30pm. To hike your gear to the site is about 300 yards up hill. Easily done with a wagon.

#### What to Bring

- Camp chairs for a comfier seat.
- Toiletries
- Ear plugs for snoring and for when the woodland creatures get noisy.
- Bug spray, bug lotion, insect repellant, and bug spray.
- Sun screen and a hat.

- Scout Uniforms for our flag ceremony and Saturday evening program.
- You'll eat more that your share at chow & snacks are not usually needed. S'mores are provided by the Camp.
- Do bring enough reusable water bottles for you and your scout. River Rats tends to be hot and sunny all day!
- Electronic devices and games are strongly *discouraged*.

#### Activities

- You are on the hook for a Friday night meal. Eat before you arrive.
- Friday after pitching our tents, we gather in the Great Hall for an orientation at 8:00pm. There you will get your T-shirts to wear the rest of the weekend.
- Saturday, we have scout activities all day with an hour of free time after lunch.
- In the past, activities have included; kickball, gaga ball, human foosball, STEM activity, bb guns, archery, craft, knots, climbing walls, geocache, and much more.

N4350 Boy Scout Rd, Saint Cloud, WI 53079-1712


Hwy 45 north through Kewaskum to Hwy 67 (Turn Right)
